My name is Andrew Grigorenko, I'm seventeen years old and now I'm a first year Dnipropetrovsk student of National University of Railway named **Transport** after academician Lazaryan. But why have I chosen this university? I have liked watching the trains since my childhood. Walking



around the park, I always led the parents to the station, where the children's train started its running. That's why in 2009, when I was in the fifth form, I decided to become a young railwayman of the Dnipropetrovsk children's railway which

is situated in the central park of our city named after zaporizhian cossack Lazar Globa. This is the establishment of non-formal education of children which is acquainting children of Dnipropetrovsk region with the railway professions. It is the first children's railway in Ukraine, the second in the Soviet Union and in the world. On the children's railway we got basic knowledge of railway transport. From November to April we attended lectures, then we passed the exam and finally we were allowed to use our skills on practice which lasted from May to October. There were three years of study. during the first and second years young railwaymen study the general course of railways and then each of them can choose which is the most interesting branch for him or her. There are four of them: traffic, locomotives, cars and track services. What about me, I decided to choose traffic service, that's why I study at the department of Transportation Process Operation. In my opinion, every resident of our city at least once a time saw the train in the park named after Lazar Globa. Young railwaymen are those who operate and maintain this train every weekend in order to give some happy hours to small kids and their parents. Of course, we are under the supervision of experienced workers of railway transport. They just watch our actions, but all work on the railroad performing maintenance by scholars of 5-11 forms. Besides, we travel to another children's railway of Ukraine in summer and attend different exhibitions, museums, enterprises, etc all the year. Also we organize parties, celebrations and cultural events. There are 6 shifts on the railroad and the work of which is controlled by the Council of young railwaymen. After learning program, most of schoolchildren decide to enter railway institutions in order to continue learning railway specialty. In our city it may be our university (DNURT named after academician Lazaryan), Dnipropetrovsk College of transport infrastructure or Dnipropetrovsk railway lyceum. This year wasn't an exception.
